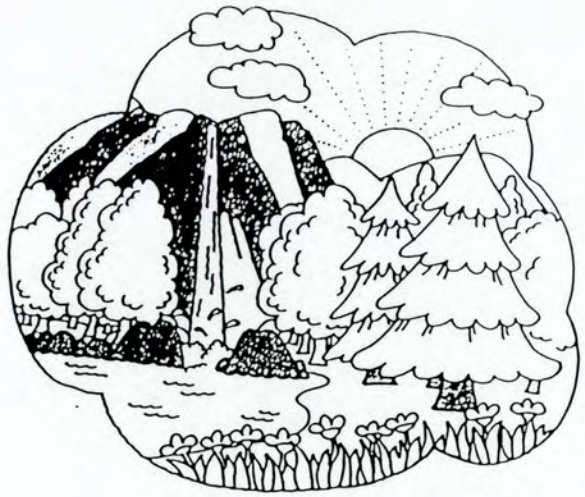

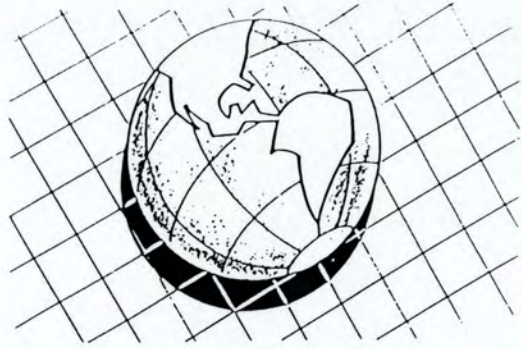

What are some things that reinforce in your mind that God created the Heavens and the Earth?

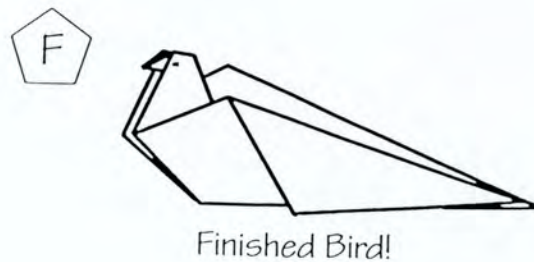
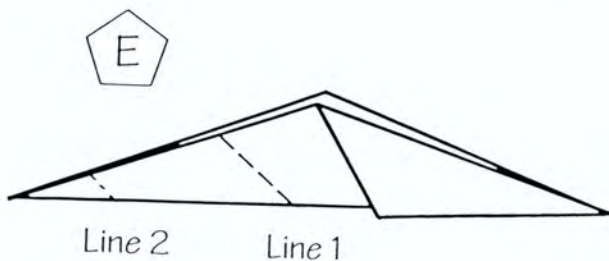
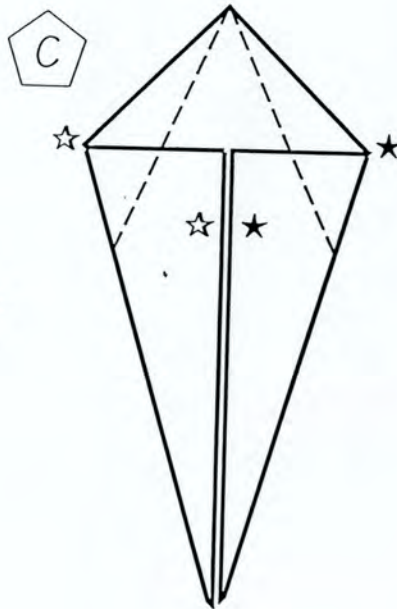
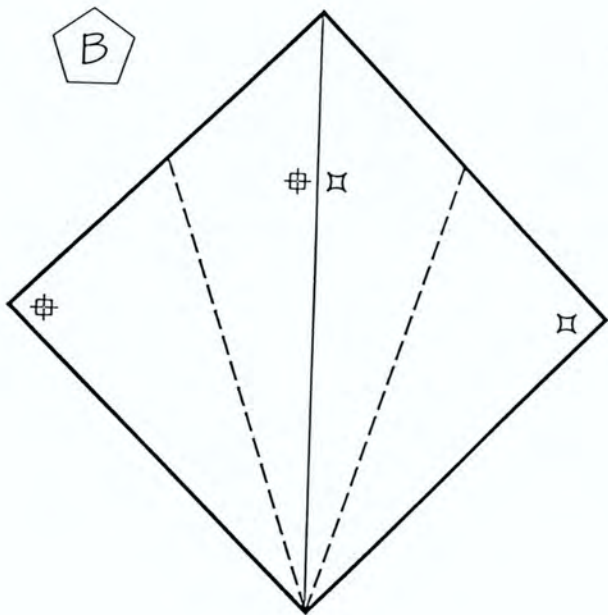
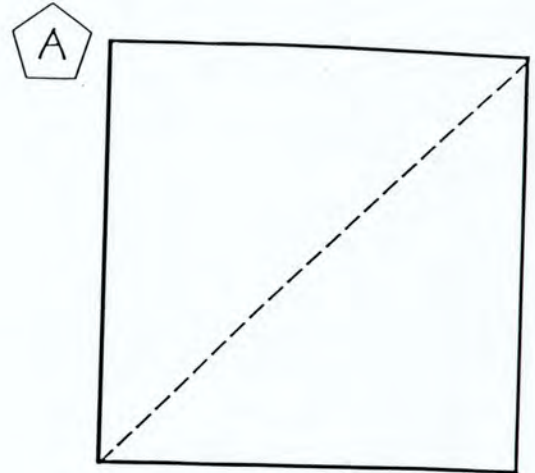
In these days how can we see God’s power demonstrated?

The Fowl of the Air

Origami is creating things by folding paper. Use the patterns below and see what types of birds you can create. Do yours look like the ones God created?

1. Fold a square piece of paper diagonally as in diagram A.
2. Open the paper and fold as shown in diagram B, matching \oplus 's and \boxplus 's.
3. Fold again as shown in diagram C, matching \star 's and \star 's to form diagram D.
4. Fold the paper in half as shown in diagram E. Then, carefully fold in line 1. This will form the neck of the bird. Next, carefully fold in line 2, which forms the head.
5. To finish the bird add eyes and add color to the body.
How many different looking birds can you create?



Lesson 1

OBJECT LESSON

Needed: Modeling compound

Make a flower or bird or other object.

We say I am making something out of clay. But am I *creating* something?
When the Bible says that God made the flowers and the birds, and people, it says he created them out of nothing. Think about it -- everything that we make here on earth -- cars, boats, planes, clothes, computers, toys -- everything was made from stuff that already existed. The shirt I am wearing was made from a cotton plant -- but who made the cotton plant?

God spoke and it was done; He commanded and it stood fast, the Bible says.

When you look at things today -- your clothes and shoes and toys -- remember that all these things were *made*, but not *created*. Only God is the Creator.
