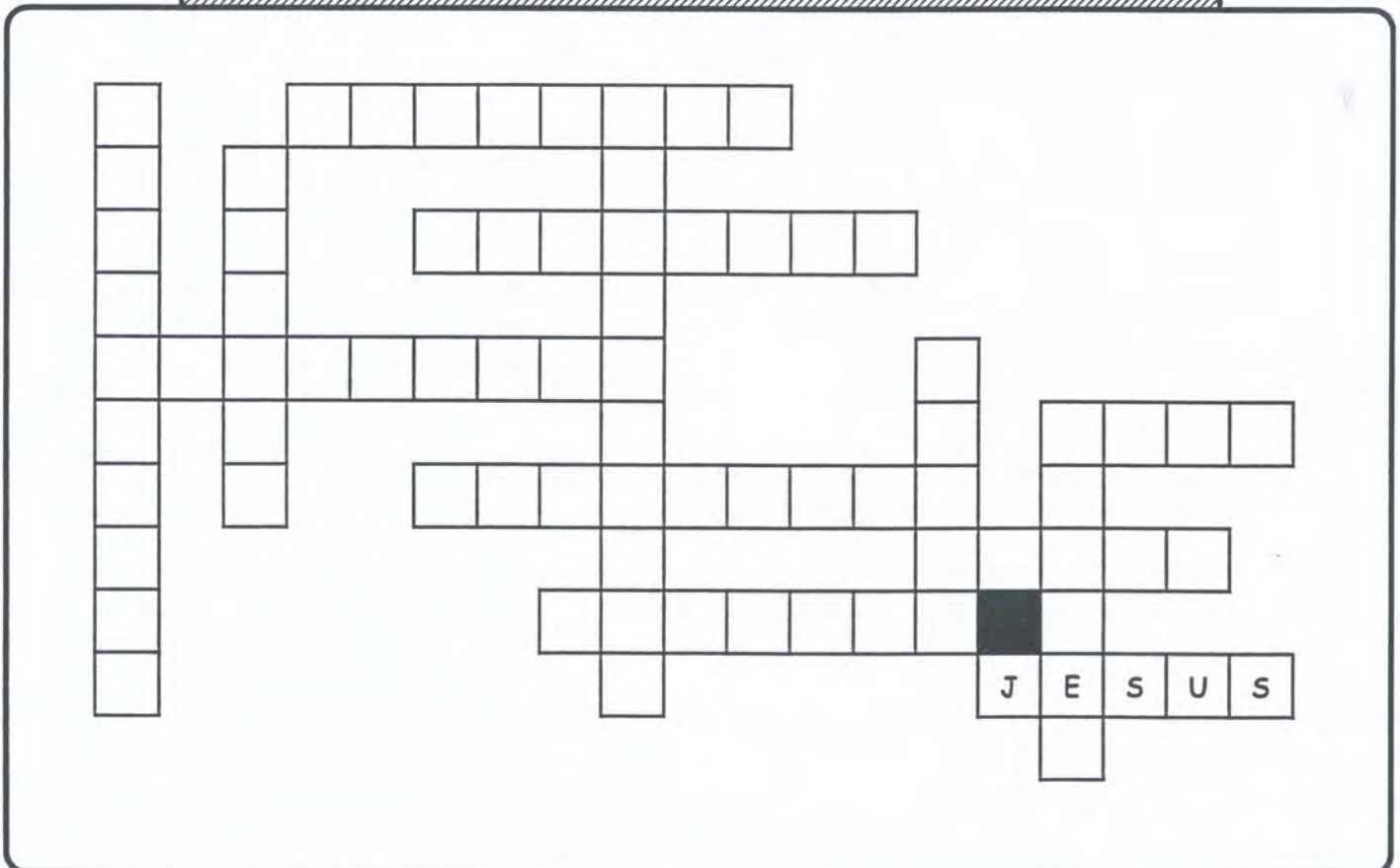


Here's the Plan, . . .
