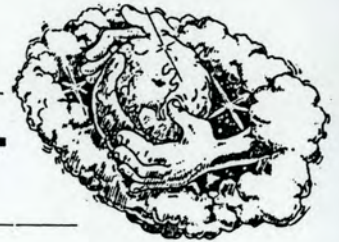

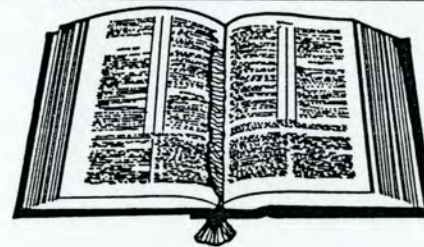

OBJECT LESSON / OPENER IDEAS

1. OBJECT – a long length of rope

To illustrate the concept of Infinity

Stretch the rope around your classroom, giving the illusion that the rope has no beginning and no end (such as in the door and out a window, or around the walls of your cubicle).

2. OBJECT – a ruler, a ball of yarn, one 24” length of yarn, one 48” length of yarn

To illustrate that we can measure things on earth, but God cannot be measured.

Measure the short and long lengths of yarn.

Show the ball of yarn and tell how, although there is a lot of yarn here, we *could* measure it if we really wanted to.

Some things cannot be measured – we have a hard time understanding that because we can measure almost everything. But God cannot be measured. Read Rev. 1:8

3. OBJECT – a birth certificate

To illustrate how each one of us had a beginning, but Jesus *always* was.

When you and I were born, that was our beginning. This birth certificate shows the exact year, month, day and time when I came into being. Jesus was also born one day, but his birth was different. Jesus had no beginning. He existed in Heaven before He came to this earth as a baby.

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.

4. OBJECT – a jar filled with ants

To illustrate the concept of Christ’s Incarnation

Once upon a time there was a boy and his father who were out walking in a field.

Accidentally, the boy stepped on an anthill, crushing several ants. He felt very sorry, but he had no way of telling the ants he was sorry. He said to his dad “If only I could become an ant, I’d be able to tell them.” His father replied, “Son, that’s like what Jesus did – He was God, and He became a man so that He could talk to us and show us the way of salvation.” Now, every time you see an ant you can think about Jesus coming to this world to die for our sins.
