Not So Clear!

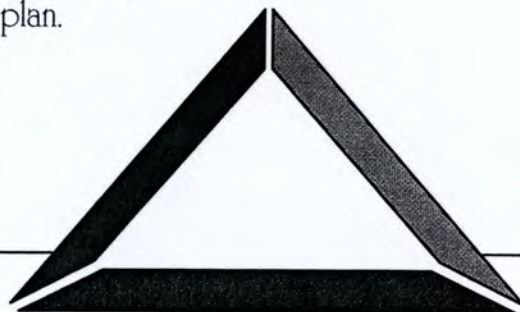
