Title: THE GREAT WHITE THRONE JUDGMENT Key Verse: Hebrews 9:27

Text/Story: I Tim 5:24,25; Rev 20:11-15

Main idea: After the Millennium, God will judge those whose names are not written in the Lamb's Book of Life according to their works.

Time	Activity	Description
	Pre-Lesson: Object Lesson	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Materials: address book, church directory, telephone books etc. • Have the class discuss what these books have in common, i.e., the purpose of these books • Have a few students look up their family's name in the telephone book to see if they are listed • Introduce the idea that record books are being kept by God
	Lesson: Questionnaire	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hand out question worksheet • Have the students work in partners or individually • Students are to read the text Rev. 20: 11-15 and answer the questions as they read • Discuss the answers when everyone has finished.
	Post Lesson: Clothesline Summary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Materials: lightweight rope or twine, clothespins, 5x7 (or larger) cards or papers, markers • Tie the rope/twine across the room • Have the class come up with a summary sentence of 8-10 words on the lesson • Each student is assigned one or two words to write on the card(s) (one word per card) • Encourage them to use big, colourful and fancy printing or writing • Hang these cards up across the clothesline in correct order.

2. Who will be standing before God when the books are opened?

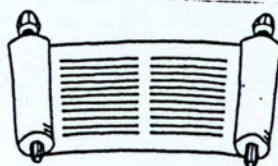
3. What is the name of one of the books God will judge from?

THE GREAT WHITE THRONE JUDGMENT Additional Activities

Play a "Name That Word" game with your students to introduce or review some of the important words in our text. On a dry erase board or chalkboard, draw a symbol representing one of the key words in the text. Have the students open their Bibles to the text, and the first one who can identify what you are drawing and explain its significance in the text should be thrown a small piece of candy. Possible words to use: Throne, earth, heaven, dead, books, sea, hell, fire.
