Text/Story: Consecration
 2 Samuel 24:17-25; Romans 12:1,2
 Main idea: Consecration is most essential to Christian growth. It is keeping one's life constantly on the altar and obeying God's will.

Key Verse: Psalm 40:8

Time	Activity	Description
	Pre-Lesson Lists: "What Do I Own?"	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Give each student a piece of paper and pencil • Have them write down all that they own which they think are of value (e.g., baseball card collection, coins, bank account, electronic gadgets etc.); rank them in order of importance • When complete ask if any would want to share his/her list • Ask students if they are willing to give away these things for a good cause • Relate this to the idea of consecration--are they willing to give these things and themselves up to God?
	Lesson Story Map	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For younger children tell the story of David's offering using flannel graph, pictures etc. • For older children have them fill out the story map after reading the passage together or in groups; be sure to fill them in on the events that led to David's dilemma • Draw parallel between the burnt offering and making consecration to God; discuss the importance of obeying God's will
	Post-Lesson Worksheet/Poster	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Distribute worksheet "Offering Myself to God" to each student • Discuss the different areas in our lives we can consecrate to God • Ask the students to draw a picture of themselves in the oval and either write or draw examples of consecration in the boxes provided
