Time	Activity	Description
	Pre-Lesson Interviews	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pair students up and provide each student with paper and pencil • Each student will interview his/her partner about his/her family; limit to 8-10 questions (e.g., how many in the family, what does father do, what does the family do together for fun, etc.) • Each student will then present the result of his/her interview with the class • Use this activity to relate to the most important activity a family can do together: the family altar/devotions
	Lesson Paraphrasing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assign each student a verse or two from Deut. 6:1-15 (some verses should be kept together) • For each verse, the student gets an index card and write down the main idea in his/her own words • Assemble the index cards in order on the wall or board and read through each one and discuss
	Post-Lesson Skits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Decide as a class what is family altar and what is not; list down on board or chart paper • As a class act out short skits exemplifying good and bad family devotions involving preschoolers, primary, preteen and teenage kids
