Title: God's Power
Text/Story: Psalm 139:1-14; Psalm 135:5,6; Mark 4:35-41; Hebrews 4:13; 1John 3:20
Main idea: God is present everywhere, all powerful and knows all things
Key Verse: Proverbs 15:3

Time	Activity	Description
	Pre-Lesson Object Lesson	(from the Teacher's Guide) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Materials: glasses/binoculars, battery and glass jar marked "air" • Describe each item and talk about their characteristics • Talk about how each item reminds us of God's attributes of omniscience (glasses/binoculars), omnipotence (battery) and omnipresence (air)
	Lesson Note taking	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Divide the class into 3 groups and provide felt pens and large paper or chart paper for each group • Assign each group one of the three attributes of God and the corresponding verses • Each group will read the verses and write down on their chart paper the key words and phrases that tell about the attribute • When complete, papers are tacked up and each group will present their findings • For younger children, select a few verses and do the note taking together as a class
	Post-Lesson Graffiti	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Materials: long sheet butcher paper or poster paper (big enough for class to write on); felt pens • Tack the sheet of paper on the wall and write GOD IS... at the top • Let students express their thoughts on what they learned and know about God's; if time permits, they can write as many as they want and use fancy lettering

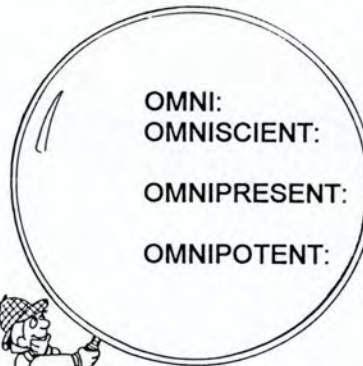

OMNI: means ALL
OMNISCIENT: (pronounced om-nish'-unt) means KNOWING ALL THINGS, PAST, PRESENT AND FUTURE
OMNIPRESENT: (pronounced omni-pre'-sent) means PRESENT EVERYWHERE AT THE SAME TIME
OMNIPOTENT: (pronounced om-nip'-otent) means HAVING UNLIMITED POWER OR AUTHORITY

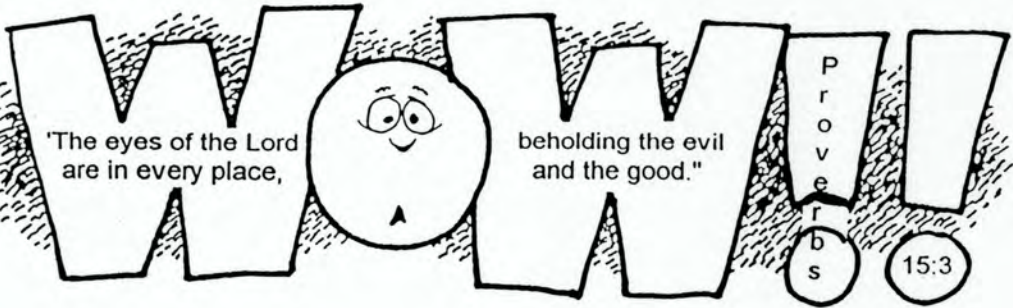
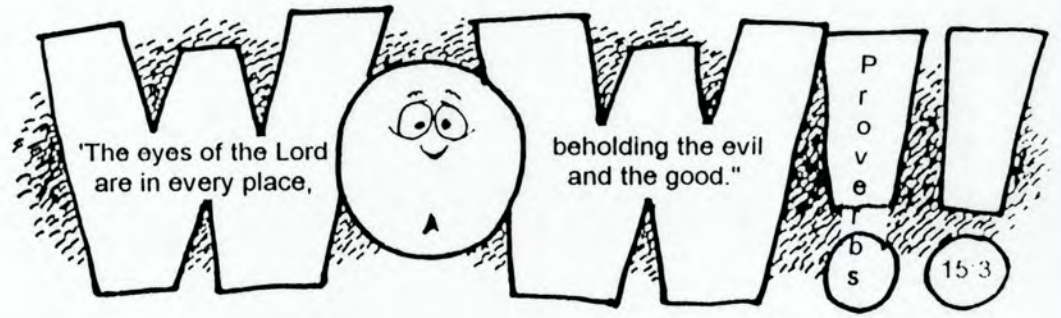
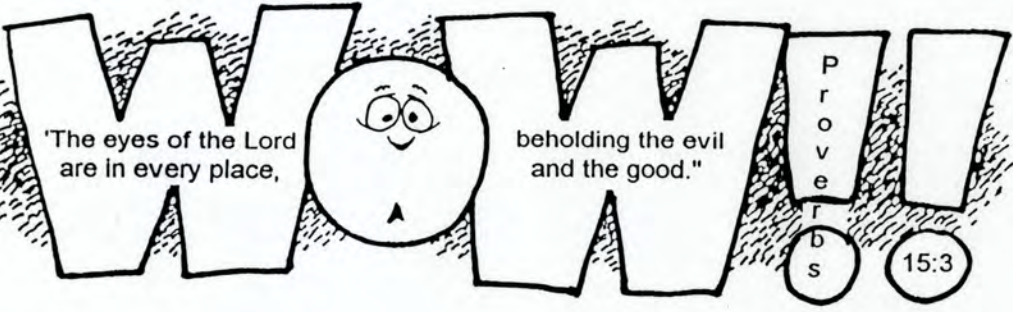
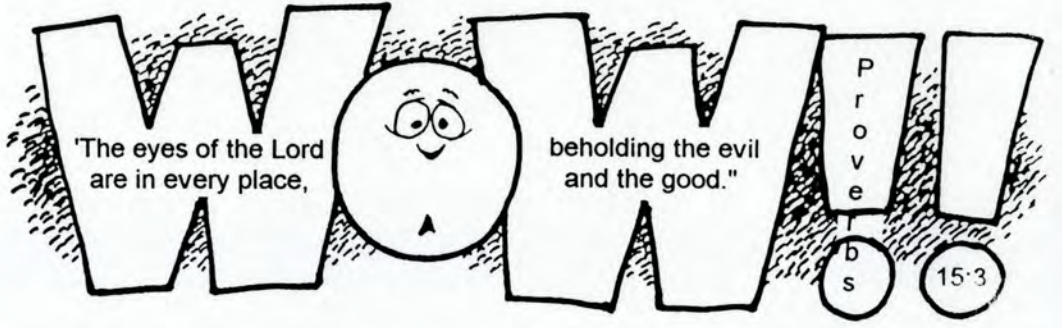
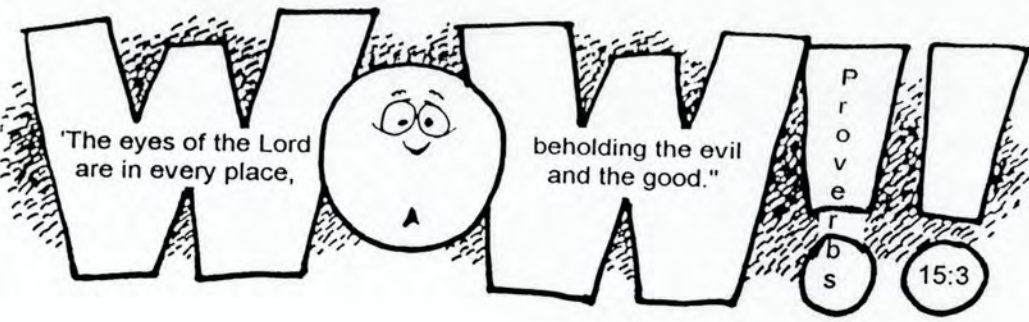
OMNISCIENT: 1 John 3:20, Hebrews 4:13, Matthew 10:29.30
