5. Marissa works at a fast food restaurant in the mall. A lady was talking to her friend and walked off without her change. It was over ten dollars in change. Marissa should _____.



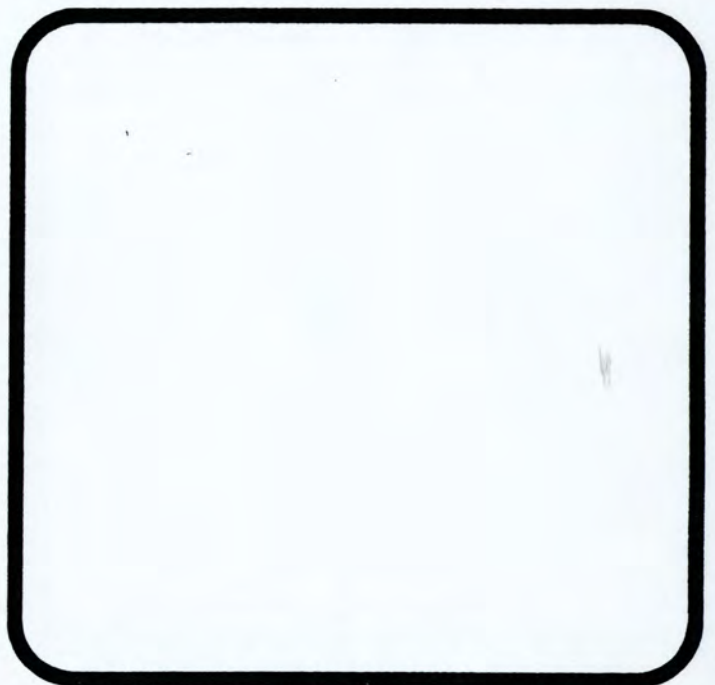
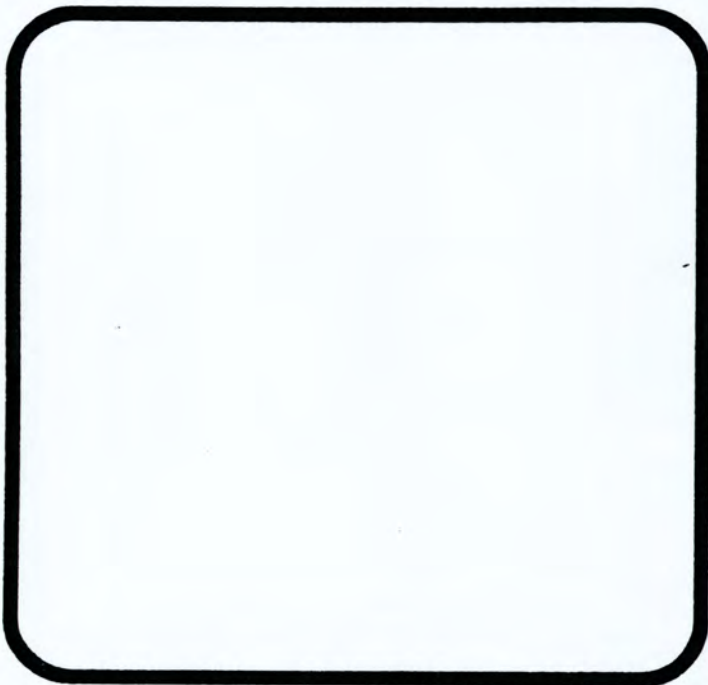
Exercising the Golden Rule is more than staying cool or neutral -- it is showing love and doing good, even when you are wronged.
