 Title: Does Jesus Still Heal Today? (Divine Healing)
 Text/Story: Isaiah 53:1-5; Mark 5:22-42; James 5:13-16
 Main idea: God provided divine healing at atonement; He still heals those that ask Him
 Key Verse: Exodus 15:26

| Time | Activity | Description |

| Pre-Lesson Creative Writing/Sharing | | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide each student with a pencil and sheet of writing paper • In five minutes, ask students to write about one sickness they've had, or had hurt or broken parts of their bodies; they can provide as much details as they want but should describe what it felt like • If time permits have them draw a picture to go with their paragraphs • Ask volunteers to share their work • Lead the discussion into the lesson on God's provision for divine healing • Option: instead of writing, group students into pairs and have them spend 2 minutes sharing their experience with being sick; have them change partners and share again |
| Lesson Mark 5:22-42 Story Presentation on Tape | | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Materials: 2 tape recorders, 2 blank cassette tapes • Divide the class into two groups • Assign one group the story of Jesus healing the woman with the issue of blood, and the other, the story of Jairus' daughter • Each group will read the verses and retell the story in their own words on cassette tape; each person in the group will need to tell a part of the story • If time permits, let groups write out what they will read • Listen to both tapes and discuss how Jesus cares about our health and needs and promises to heal us if we ask |
| Post-Lesson Get Well Cards | | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Materials: 9" x 12" coloured card or construction paper, felt pens, old greeting cards, glitter, stencils, calendar pictures, etc. • Fold the paper in half to make a greeting card; have each student design a get well card using any of the materials you supply • Have them add a scripture on the card related to God's promise to heal • Options: Keep the cards and send them to sick students in the future; send the cards to church folks who are sick |
