 Title: Looking Ahead (Eternal Life)  
 Text/Story: Luke 16:19-31; John 14:1-3  
 Main idea: God offers eternal life with Him in Heaven to those who trust Him.  
 Key Verse: Romans 6:23

Time	Activity	Description
	Pre-Lesson  Word Association/List	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• On chart paper, chalk board, or overhead, make a two column table</li> <li>• Write down a word one at a time on the left-hand column and have the students come up with the word that is opposite to it (e.g., black/white, in/out, big/small, up/down, night/day, etc.); everyone can shout out the words (do about 12-15)</li> <li>• Use the words heaven/hell at the end of the list to introduce the lesson</li> </ul>
	Lesson  Luke 16:19-31; John 14:1-3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read the story together; use objects to illustrate (e.g., fine cloth, picture of a delicious meal, Band-Aids, bread crumbs, bowl of water, pictures of heart and mansion)</li> <li>• Discuss the differences between heaven and hell; emphasize the fact that we choose where we spend eternity and God had provided a beautiful place for those who are redeemed</li> <li>• Answer any questions they might have about heaven and hell if possible</li> </ul>
	Post-Lesson  "What Do You Think" Worksheet	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provide each student with a pencil and worksheet</li> <li>• Students can work in pairs to complete the work; ask them to be sure they can back up their answers with evidence from scripture; for younger children, do the worksheet together</li> <li>• Other verses they might need: John 17:1-3; Rev. 20:12-15; Deu. 30:19; Rom 6:23; John 3:3-8</li> <li>• Discuss their answers</li> </ul>
