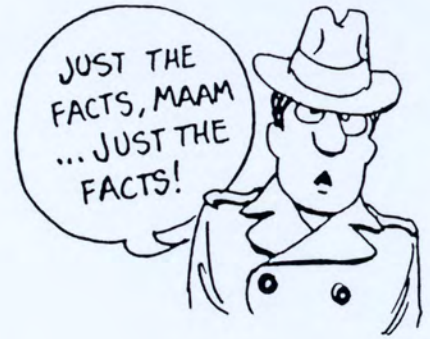

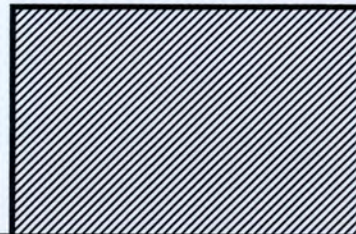

3. Your friends from school are going out drinking, and they say you're a geek not to go?

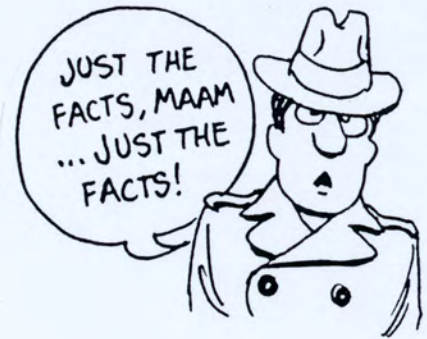
4. You've wanted a date with this one guy for a long time. You finally get to go out with him, but then he pressures you to go "to far"?
