

QUARTER REVIEW

ENLIST THE HELP OF SOME SR. ADULTS AND HAVE THEM DRESS IN COSTUME REPRESENTING ONE OF THE PEOPLE STUDIED THIS QUARTER. AHEAD OF TIME GIVE THEM A LIST OF SOME OF THE CHARACTERISTICS DISCUSSED IN CLASS. LET THE STUDENTS TAKE TURNS ASKING THEM SIMPLE QUESTIONS AND TRY TO GUESS WHAT PERSONALITY THEY ARE PORTRAYING. AT THE END OF CLASS INVITE THE SENIORS TO STAY AND SHARE IN REFRESHMENTS IF THERE IS TIME. THE FOLLOWING WEEK HAVE A THANK-YOU CARD FOR YOUR CLASS TO SIGN FOR EACH SR. PARTICIPANT (since there were only two women studied, throw your kids a curve by having a man portray them and some of the men portrayed by women!)

SET THE CLASS CHAIRS IN A CIRCLE AND GIVE EACH STUDENT A LATEX BALLOON (UNINFLATED), A PIECE OF PAPER AND A PENCIL. ASSIGN THEM EACH A LESSON (THERE CAN BE MORE THAN ONE STUDENT ASSIGNED THE SAME ONE) AND HAVE THEM WRITE A QUESTION PERTAINING TO THAT LESSON. HAVE THEM ROLL UP THE QUESTION AND PUT IT IN THE BALLOON AND THEN BLOW UP THE BALLOON AND TIE IT OFF. HAVE A PERMANENT MARKER TO PASS AROUND AND HAVE THEM WRITE THEIR NAME ON THEIR BALLOON. (THIS WILL INSURE THEY DON'T TAKE THEIR OWN BALLOON LATER AND ALSO MAKE THEM ACCOUNTABLE FOR RESPONSIBLE QUESTIONS, I HOPE!) PUT ALL THE BALLOONS IN THE CENTER OF THE CIRCLE, DRAW THEIR NAME, HAVE THEM SELECT A BALLOON AND CORRECTLY ANSWER THE QUESTION. IF THEY CAN'T ANSWER CORRECTLY, THE NEXT PERSON DRAWN CAN EITHER ANSWER THAT QUESTION OR SELECT ANOTHER BALLOON.

HAVE A LUNCH BAG FOR EACH PERSONALITY STUDIED, LABELED IN LARGE LETTERS AND LINED UP IN A ROW. LET EACH STUDENT SELECT A CHARACTERISTIC YOU HAVE PREPARED FROM ANOTHER BAG AND DROP IT IN THE BAG THEY THINK MOST FITS THAT CHARACTERISTIC. THEY THEN MUST EXPLAIN THEIR CHOICE TO THE REST OF THE CLASS.

ARRANGE THE CHAIRS IN A CIRCLE, HAVE SEVERAL QUESTIONS IN A CONTAINER WITH A TIGHT FITTING LID. PLAY MUSIC EITHER LIVE OR TAPED AND THE CONTAINER MUST KEEP MOVING AROUND THE CIRCLE AS THE MUSIC PLAYS. WHEN THE MUSIC STOPS THE ONE HOLDING THE CONTAINER MUST OPEN IT AND TAKE OUT A QUESTION. IF THEY CAN CORRECTLY ANSWER IT, THEY RECEIVE A PRIZE. IF NOT, IT GOES BACK INTO THE CONTAINER AND THE MUSIC RESUMES.

ASSIGN EACH STUDENT OR PAIR OF STUDENTS A CHARACTER AND GIVE THEM 3 MINUTES. THEY MUST THEN ACT OUT THAT CHARACTER FOR THE REST OF THE CLASS TO GUESS.

DIVIDE THE CLASS INTO TEAMS, SELECT QUESTIONS FROM THEIR ANSWER ACTIVITY PAGES OR MAKE UP YOUR OWN AND PLAY TIC TAC TOE

WRITE CHARACTERISTICS ON A LARGE BOARD AND THEN HAVE THEM LIST THE CHARACTERS UNDER EACH CHARACTERISTIC
